ABOUT THE PROGRAM

In its vision to build a lasting bridge between the United States and India, AIF has proudly launched the AIF Youth Ambassador Program (AYAP), a service-learning experience in India for U.S. high school students.

AYAP seeks to foster an awareness of social development in India among its participants through visits with local communities, Indian peers & schools, leading NGOs, and the private sector. Students engage with an AIF service-learning curriculum and are exposed to issues of poverty and other challenges facing vulnerable communities.

Participants will engage with Indian peers on multiple occasions to build relationships and work together to come up with solutions to local problems. Students learn how to make sense of development challenges and to help advance social justice.

Upon returning to the U.S., students are inspired to advance social change in India and beyond. AYAP creates a long-term leadership opportunity for continued collaboration with AIF, its program and the communities served.

The AIF Youth Ambassador Program seeks to:

- Facilitate an understanding of social, economic and environmental challenges facing marginalized communities in India
- Foster two-way cultural awareness among students from the U.S. and India
- Expose students to the NGO & private sector roles in advancing social justice
- Explore frugal innovations in education, livelihood and environmental challenges
- Set the stage for continued collaboration with AIF
- Assist Youth Ambassadors in developing their individual social responsibility to the local and global community at large
